## **1. English Language (50 Marks)**

- Reading Comprehension (35–40 Questions): Inference, main idea, tone, argument structure, contextual vocabulary.
- Vocabulary (5–8 Questions): Synonyms, antonyms, word usage in context, idioms and phrases.
- Grammar & Usage (5–7 Questions): Error detection, sentence correction, para jumbles, fill in the blanks.

## **2. Logical Reasoning (70 Marks)**

- Analytical Reasoning (35–40 Questions): Seating arrangement, blood relations, direction sense, ranking, coding-decoding, series, syllogism, statement & conclusion, cause & effect.
- Critical Reasoning (30–35 Questions): Assumptions, strengthen/weaken arguments, logical flaws, identifying conclusions, inference-based reasoning.

## **3. Current Affairs & General Knowledge (30 Marks)**

- Current Affairs (20–25 Questions): National and international news, legal developments, government schemes, Supreme Court judgments, economy, appointments, awards, sports.
- Static GK (5–10 Questions): Indian Constitution basics, polity, history, geography, international organizations, important days.
